2a	The team have the opportunity to train together before European / International championships to enhance team spirit.
	Team Leader and Team Coach for European & International Competitions will be selected by the BCCMA Executive Committee.

1	Must be a fully paid up member of the BCCMA
2	An Athlete must be of good character
3	Be dedicated to the goal of achievement
4	Develop Team Spirit by encouraging other team members
5	Attend training sessions on a regular basis where appropriate.
6	Comply with the decisions of the Team Manager / Leader
7	Motivate themselves to get their own sponsorship (e.g.: local sports council - local businesses etc) advertising of sponsor at the discretion of the BCCMA

9	Points threshold for BCCMA sponsorship for the 12 to 15 age categories combined across three disciplines (open hand, short & long weapon) of 25.2, with an average score of 8.4 per event.
10	Points threshold for BCCMA sponsorship for the 15 to 18 age categories combined across three disciplines (open hand, short & long weapon) of 26.4, with an average score of 8.8 per event (two in Taijiquan & Taijijian).
