Roadmap for easing Lockdown

As from 29th March the rule of 6 applies to be allowed to meet outside for formally organised outdoor sports.

29 March – Step 1 (Rule of 6)

- Maximum 6 people in the group (1 Instructor 5 students)
- Social distancing to be maintained 2 metres apart.
- No contact to be made i.e., no pad work / no partner work / no sparring etc.
- If you are planning to teach in a public park, check with local council if licence required.

12 April – Step 2

- Same ruling as above applies.

17 May – Step 3

- **Outdoors** most of the social distancing rules hopefully should be lifted, and will allow up to 30 to participate,
- **Indoors**, however the rule of 6 will apply.

21st June – Step 4

- All legal limits for social contact are expected to be removed.
