## Invitation for the British Traditional Wushu Squad Selection

British Traditional Taolu Squad Selection will take place on 11th July 2021.

The selection is open to all Chinese Traditional Martial Arts practitioners, who are practicing, at least 1 year before lockdown, Chinese Martial Arts.

The purpose of this event is to select members for the British Traditional Wushu Squad.

Squad members will have the opportunity to be chosen to be part of the British Traditional Wushu Team to represent the United Kingdom by taking part of any European or International championship or events. The venue has a Covid - 19 safety plan and we are committed to keeping you safe.

### Requirements

- 1) Athletes would like to be considered for the British Traditional Squad must attend the selection which will take place on Sunday 11th July 2021 at 11 am @China Spirit UK (150 Birkenhead Road, Wallasey, Wirral, CH44 7JN)
- 2) The selection starts at 11 am with guided warm up, where athletes will be observed, as a first part of the selection. Second part of the selection is performance of traditional forms: 1 hand forms, 1 short weapon form, and 1 long, soft or other special weapon form.
- 3) The selection performances will be scored by certified BCCMA judges (A and B / 5+5)
- 4) Athletes not able to attend on the day of the selection, can send video of their performance. For more information, please contact [xingbo.liu@bccma.com](mailto:xingbo.liu@bccma.com)
- 5) Athletes must be fully paid members of the British Council of Chinese Martial Arts, BCCMA
- 6) Athletes must have valid British passport
- 7) Athletes are willing to travel to European or International championships or events.
- 8) All athletes agree to abide by the rulings of BCCMA in all matters concerning European and International events, including selection, travel, accommodation, publicity and insurance
- 9) Sponsorship is available in line with the BCCMA guidelines
- 10) At the absolute discretion of the BCCMA Executive, (head of Traditional Squad) Xingbo Liu, if an athlete is unsuccessful at the squad selection, but it is considered that the athlete may benefit from selection to enhance their development or to gain experience, the Athlete will be offered a space in the British Traditional Wushu Squad.
